There were also members of the public present.

There was a motion by Bob Reynolds, second by Marilyn Bayerl to accept the October 2010 minutes as submitted. Carried.

Treasurer Peterson distributed copies and reviewed the financial reports. The October 31, 2010 balance in checking was \$7,998.59. There are bills to pay from Country Secretary - \$183.75, \$840.00 from RMB Labs, Minnesota IS Conference - \$220.00 plus expenses and \$12.50 from Infolink. There was a motion by Marilyn Bayerl, second by Jan Beliveau to accept the Treasurer’s report and pay all bills. Motion carried.

Joe Bischoff from Wenck gave an excellent overhead presentation on Lake Winona and the TMDL process. His conclusions include that the current TMDL as submitted to the EPA is not chlorophyll A based carp has impacted lake readings significantly and Lake Winona at 88 ug/Ltp will be protective of downstream lakes. There was a lengthy question and answer period. After considerable discussion, there was a motion by Jan Beliveau, second by Dick Kuehn to table the issue of Lake Winona, that was requested by the Chain of Lakes Partnership, until next month. Motion carried.

President Huettl announced we are still in need of a PR coordinator. The job entails lining up speakers for KXRA Open Line and getting them to attend and speak at our meetings.

The report result from the water monitors are available from RMB Labs. Karen Cook asked which data was wanted. Reams of information are available.

Sue Engstrom reported quiet on the Zoning front.

President Huettl told the group we will hold on the Awards program.

President Huettl announced that we got the non-profit postage rate of .15 each for our newsletters. She is getting bids for folding and mailing. Content for the newsletter is needed. Submitted grant request to Tastefully Simple to help with cost estimated to be \$2500 for 6000 newsletters.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
