Harry May reported on behalf of Public Relations. Next month's Open Line radio spot will be filled by fishing guides.

There was discussion of the upcoming Kids Day at the Lake.

Steve Henry reported on the blue solar powered lighted buoys. There is a five year warranty on the solar battery. The cost is \$495 for 2. He asked if there are other lakes interested.

President Jan reported that there is a company that wants to do new testing for zebra mussels in Douglas County. Dr. Michael McCartney will keep President Jan informed. Becca Nash is in charge of this project through the University of Minnesota.

Steve Henry told the group that there is a two acre patch of Eurasian Milfoil in Lake LeHommeDieu. They have contracted with PLM for treatment. It is supposed to be 80 to 90% effective. They will survey the lake in a 12 hour period.

The Lake Winona TMDL results will be back by June 4<sup>th</sup>.

The Water Conference report will be presented at a future meeting.

Jeff Forester of Minnesota Lakes and Rivers Advocates spoke at this time. He gave an update of their history. They are pushing for a bonding bill this session. There was a motion by Linda Dokken-McFann, second by Sue Engstrom to join the MLR. Carried.
